South Paulding Tournament Deposit Fee and Parent Expectations: Everyone is required to submit a separate deposit check for \$150 for 1 child or a \$175 check to cover multiple children (in the same household) to guarantee you work the all the events we are scheduled to work . This check will be held (not deposited) until OUR SEASON HAS ENDED to make sure everyone does their part. We will be hosting 2 events plus working 2 additional events this year. Everyone will be **REQUIRED** to work them.

- The 1st will be giving any assistance to the High School Team in the County Championships Friday Dec 19, 2019
- The 2nd will be giving any assistance to the High School Team in their Duals on Jan 4th, 2020
- The 3rd will be possibly running a Novice Tournament on Jan 5th, 2020
- The 4th will be the Spartan Challenge event on February 22nd (this includes set-up the night before on Feb 21st)
- The last events are the State Tournaments (Our team working this is required by state)
 - Big Kids State on Feb 29th (location to be determined)
 - Small Kids State on March 1st (location to be determined)
- We will require help from everyone for the Spartan Duals, the Spartan Challenge and the State Tournaments.
- These are our fund raisers. They keep our program running, but more than that they are what separates our team from the rest of the state. We are a family unit that works hard and shows the state who South Paulding is! This takes place instead of you having to sell stuff all season. Everyone that works these Tournaments will get their checks back at the banquet. Anyone that does not work (without an acceptable reason -given to Coach Byers)... **WILL NOT** get their check back and it will be deposited – no exceptions. _____ (Initial)_____
- Should your son quit before the Spartan Challenge then you FORFEIT the check and it will be deposited. Please plan to have sitters for small children that week-end. We will need everyone. I understand that many kids may not qualify for the state tournament but I will still need your help at this event. The state withholds 15% from our check we earn for the Spartan Challenge and does not pay us until we have worked the State Tournaments. Workers will not have to pay to get in. So if it happens that your son does not make it to state this year then plan to car pool with others to work the event and support the team or bring your son & family anyway to see how amazing State is.
